Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam – In response to the recent disasters that have struck Japan, seventeen artists from Vietnam as well as the international community have contributed artworks to raise money for *Red Cross Japan*. These artworks, comprising various media including painting, drawing, installation, photo and video, will be shown in the exhibition "*Tohoku no Tomodachi (Friends of Tohoku): Art Fundraiser for Japan*," organized by Tiffany Chung and Pamela Corey in collaboration with Galerie Quynh. From April 15 -29, works by this group of artists will be available for purchase (with prices ranging from US\$300 to US\$10,000) and 100% of proceeds from sales will go to Red Cross Japan.
